

Notification Requirements for Urban Area Permits

Prior to filing an application for a permit to drill a well in an urban area, the applicant must:

Provide notice of the application by regular mail to each property owner whose property is within 500 feet of the surface location of the well and also to the executive authority of the municipal corporation or the board of township trustees in which the well is to be located.

In addition, the notice shall contain a statement that informs the owner of a rental property that within five days of receipt of notice as required above, the rental property owner must provide notice to each resident of an occupied dwelling on the owner's property.

The notice shall also contain a statement that an application has been filed with the Division of Mineral Resources Management, identify the applicant and location of the well, provide the name and address of the Division and state that any comments regarding the application may be sent to the Division.
